INITIAL PARAMEDIC ACCREDITATION

- APPLICATION** - Complete Paramedic Accreditation Packet (Signed and Dated)
- CALIFORNIA PARAMEDIC LICENSE** - Copy (front and back) of Current CA Paramedic License
- PROOF OF EMPLOYMENT** - Completed "Statement of Affiliation with Service Provider" form documenting employment with an approved Imperial County ALS Provider Agency
- STATEMENT OF ELIGIBILITY** - Signed and dated as required by CA H&SC Section 1798.200
- BLS CARD** - Copy (front and back) of Healthcare Provider CPR card
- DOJ LIVESCAN** - Provide proof of request for a California Department of Justice (DOJ) Live Scan and Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) criminal background check
- VALID ID** - Copy of valid driver's license, identification card, or federal issued passport
- PROTOCOL EXAM / FIELD EVALUATION** - If you did not complete your paramedic training program in Imperial County, additional accreditation requirements (i.e. Protocol Exam, Field Evaluation, etc.) will be scheduled by Imperial County EMS Agency staff.
- PAYMENT OF FEES** - Non-refundable accreditation fee of \$20; Cash, money orders, credit & debit cards are accepted. Payment can be completed by phone at (442)265-1444. **DO NOT MAIL CASH**
- PROCESSING** - Applications for certification may be submitted via Email to EMS@co.imperial.ca.us. Application may also be brought or mailed to the Imperial County Public Health Department located at 935 Broadway Avenue in El Centro.
